CHATEAU LALAUDEY 2013 – AOC MOULIS (CRU BOURGEOIS CLASSEMENT 2015)



VINEYARD

Terroir: Bouqueyran Hill, tertiary gravels (Pyrenean gravel).
Surface: 17 ha in production
Average age of vines: 25 years old
Grape varieties: 55 % Cabernet Sauvignon - 43 % Merlot – 2 % Cabernet Franc
Density: 6 600 to 10 000 vines per hectare
Production: 37,5 hl per hectare
Annual production: 60 000 bottles

AGEING

100 % high quality French oak barrels
8 different coopers
50 % in new barrels and 50 % in one wine barrels
14 to 18 months of ageing
Light filtration before bottling

VINIFICATION

Manual harvest at the best of maturity. Selection in the vineyard and after destalking.
No crushing, maceration prior to fermentation, mixing and racking.
Long fermentation of skins.
