AGEING

100 % high quality French oak barrels

Light filtration before bottling

VINIFICATION

Late harvest at optimum maturity.

Sorting in the vineyard, sorting after de-stemming, no crushing, maceration, pumping and power cuts.

Long fermentation.

TASTING (Neil Martin – February 2012)

The Pomeys 2009 has a very attractive, almost Margaux-like nose with great purity. The palate is very succulent with pure black cherry and boysenberry fruit well-integrated creamy new oak which makes it nigh irresistible towards the finish. Very fine.
