### VINEYARD

Terroir: Bouqueyran Hill, tertiary gravels (Pyrenean gravel)

Surface: 10.28 ha in production

Average age of vines: 25 years old

Grape varieties: 55 % Merlot - 45 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Density: 6 600 vines/ha

Production: 40 hl/ha

### AGEING

100 % high quality French oak barrels

5 different coopers

1/3 in new barrels, 1/3 one wine barrels, 1/3 two wines barrels

12 months of ageing

Light filtration before bottling

### VINIFICATION

Late harvest at optimum maturity.

Sorting in the vineyard, sorting after de-stemming, no crushing, maceration, pumping and power cuts.

Long fermentation.
